Subject: Letter of Recommendation for Vazirakhon Bekturdieva

Dear Members of the Admissions Committee,

It is my pleasure to recommend Vazirakhon Bekturdieva for admission to your undergraduate program in International Relations and Politics. I am the Head of the German Department and German language teacher at Secondary School No. 51 in Samarkand, and I have taught and mentored Vazirakhon for the past four years, both inside the classroom and through extracurricular language competitions.

Vazirakhon is one of the most disciplined and linguistically gifted students I have taught. Under my guidance, she prepared for and passed the DSD I examination (Deutsches Sprachdiplom der Kultusministerkonferenz), achieving B1-level certification in reading, listening, written, and oral communication, and she is now preparing for the more advanced DSD II exam. Her results in competition are remarkable. She earned third place at the regional German Language Olympiad and second place at the city-level Olympiad. She competed against strong students from across Samarkand city and wider region. Alongside her progress in German, she has also learned English language pretty rapidly, achieving an overall band score of 7.0 on the IELTS test.

I also had the pleasure of coaching Vazirakhon as part of our school's team for Jugend debattiert, a German-language debate program supported by the German Pädagogischer Austauschdienst (PAD), where she placed first in the school final of Jugend debattiert Uzbekistan 2026. As a result, she won a fully funded trip to Germany PAD program. Preparing for competitive debate demands more than language fluency: it requires structured argumentation, quick critical thinking, and the composure to defend a position under pressure. As I observed, she developed these qualities steadily through months of preparation. This same strength in public speaking and argumentation carried into her participation as a delegate representing South Korea at Cambridge MUN 2026 in Samarkand recently, where she engaged directly with the kind of international affairs topics she now wishes to study formally at university.

Beyond her academic and competitive record, Vazirakhon has shown genuine leadership among her peers, regularly supporting younger students preparing for German language exams. She is dependable, self-motivated, and consistently well prepared. These qualities will serve her well in a rigorous university environment abroad.

I strongly recommend Vazirakhon Bekturdieva for your undergraduate program. Her linguistic ability, competitive achievements, and genuine interest in international affairs make her an excellent candidate for a demanding program in International Relations and Politics.
